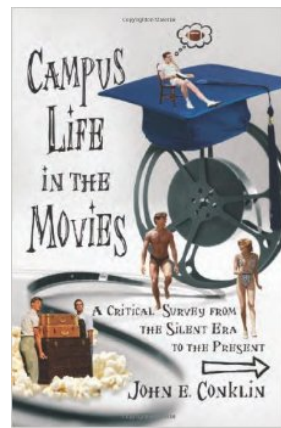
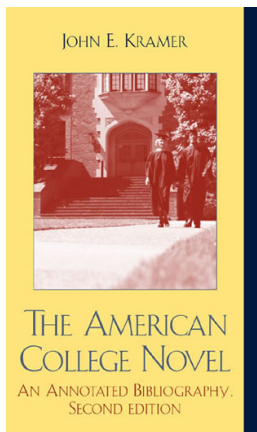


Higher Education in Popular Culture
